Hiroko KIMURA was born as a daughter of Dr. Tadashi Niimi, who developed the soil-covered sewerage system, *Dojo-Joka System*. Since her graduation for the Japan Women's University, she spent the first few years as a pre-primary school teacher. Then she joined forces to his father as his PA in 1973, and she founded a new consulting firm specializing in the construction of sewerage plants with *Dojo-Joka System*. Her company, Mokan-Joka System (MJS), has facilitated the installation of more than 300 units of *Dojo-Joka System* in the urban sewerage and rural drainage works as well as installation of combination septic tanks.
